From the Director's Desk

DAY 1: Did you ever have so much on your mind that you couldn't focus? That's where I am today as I write this column.

* The Walk for Life is over, and we're still logging in pledge monies.

* Our second eight week session of Circle of Friends and Road to Fatherhood ended, and HUGS classes are ongoing.

* We're using our Donor software, but I haven't figured out how to print out "thank you" letters.

* We think we have the Client software figured out, but there's no time to enter the information.

* The annual Christmas card has been mailed, but I know I missed some who should have received it.

* Pages 5-7 of this newsletter has a lot of names. I've gone over them so many times I see them in my sleep. But, did I leave someone out?



* I want to clean off my desk, but each pile represents something that still needs to be done.

* A father came in this morning asking if we gave out Christmas presents to clients. We don't, but someone left a bag of used toys on our front porch over the weekend and he found a few things for his children. So many children out there without parents who care if they receive anything for Christmas.

* A message was left over the weekend from a girl who just found out she was pregnant and didn't know what to do. We weren't here and missed the call. So far I haven't been able to reach her. The desperation in her voice breaks my heart.

* Every day clients come for diapers and formula. If we have what they need, it's theirs. If not, they must go elsewhere for help. Does anyone else give diapers and formula to those in need?

* Last week a grandmother received a call about her four grandchildren. If she didn't come and get them, they were on their way to foster care. Their mother had been arrested for drugs. A friend told her about the Center, and grandma became a client.

* Since the Supreme Court ruling on gay marriage earlier this year, our schools are in confusion about so many issues. All of our abstinence curriculum had to be updated. What will this ruling do to the future of our abstinence program?

* Our tax exempt status is still up in the air, but the paperwork is almost finished and we are about ready to submit all the forms. How long will it take to be reinstated?

DAY 2, PART 1: Had a wonderful night last night speaking for a very special group of women. Worn out this morning, but ready to get back to this column with a more positive attitude.

DAY 2, PART 2: It's now 2:00 p.m. and I'm just now getting back to my column.

* Call this morning from the CPA working on our tax exempt situation. Needed to go through five years of donor information to get him the final pieces of the puzzle so the paperwork can be completed, signed and sent off.

* A full day today with clients and classes. Thank you, Father, for Deanna and our volunteers.
